Short Story Writing Competition

Feeling inspired from our recent visit from the author **Catherine Emmett**, we would like to hold a short story writing competition.

Catherine enthusiastically engaged the children with her storytelling as well as sharing the journey a story takes from initial idea to publication.

The theme for our competition will be based on our 6Rs: respect, resilience, responsibility, resourcefulness, reasoning and reflection.

Each child can either write a short story linked to the theme or base the story around one or more of the characters, e.g. a robot story.

Please try to write no more than 500 words.

It would be amazing if the children could draw some illustrations for their stories.

There will be three categories for prizes:

Group 1: Age 5-7 (Year 1 and 2)

Group 2: Age 7-9 (Year 3 and 4)

Group 3: Age 9-11 (Year 5 and 6)

We are delighted that Catherine would like to come back to Thaxted School to present the prizes and she has expressed that she would like to read the shortlisted stories. We are thrilled that she has offered to do this.

There will be a **book** and **certificate** presented in assembly for each

category. Each child who enters will also receive a certificate and small gift (pencil and rubber).

The deadline for entries is Friday 17th March and winners will be announced the following week.
