School day timings

The school day has now changed to come into line with the Government expectations from March 2022. The school week is from the morning registration until the end of the school day (including breaks) and the Government set a standard of all children receiving a minimum of 32.5hours a week. Previously our registration ended at 9am and the day finished at 3.15pm, this equated to 31.25 hours a week.

Our new day of registration closes at 8.50am. Classrooms open and children are expected in between 8.40am - 8.50am, (gates open 8.30am). The end of day is 3.20pm and this equates to the minimum of 32.5hours a week. Children are receiving an extra 15minutes of learning time a day.

The school gates are opened earlier in the morning to make it safer, as children and their families do not need to queue by the road. A whistle will be blown to indicate the opening of classrooms and to allow Reception parents to escort their children up to Donaldson and Rosen classrooms. Children can enter their classrooms any time from 8.40am but they must be in before 8.50am, otherwise they will receive a late mark.

The Early Years staff request that parents dissuade their children from touching the equipment put out in the Early Years outside area, so that it can be ready for the first lesson in the morning.

Also a polite reminder that no children should be playing upon the trim trail in the main playground in the mornings or after school.

Flu vaccine

If your child missed their Flu vaccine or you have changed your mind, any parent is able to contact the Vaccine team and they can offer a clinic appointment for your child to receive the vaccine.

NITS

Both children and parents are vulnerable to head lice and we do get them from time to time in school, but they can be a pain to get rid of.

In fact, one in three children in the UK may get head lice at some point during the year - so what is a parent to do?

Some strains of head lice have grown more resistant to chemical treatments designed to kill them, but they are still vulnerable to being removed via combing, or through suffocation using some treatments.

<u>Do not try</u> alternatives to head lice treatments, such as olive oil, regular conditioner, vinegar and even mouth wash. <u>Only use specific</u> treatments designed to kill head lice.

The best advice is to treat all in the household and change all the bedsheets.
