Be an Investigator Find the places mentioned in the story on an atlas or map and find out about the places.</p> <p>4. Be a Chef Paddington's favourite food is marmalade. Find a recipe and make your own marmalade - it's delicious on toast.</p> <p>5. Be an Explorer Learn about Peru, where Paddington Bear is from?</p> <p>6. Go on a Paddington Bear picnic Take a friend or your family on a picnic and play games and tell stories. Marmalade sandwiches must be included.</p>	<p>1. Be an artist Design an alien. Draw and label an alien who might live on another planet. Write about what it eats, how it moves and what it looks like.</p> <p>2. Be an Inventor Design and create a rocket model using recycled materials. Think carefully about the features that you would like to include. What would you take up to space?</p> <p>3. Be a Researcher What is in the night sky? Find out the names of the planets in our solar system and research which are closest to Earth. You may wish to draw the planets and label them, or make them into a 3D model.</p> <p>4. Be a Writer Imagine you are an astronaut and you travel to the Moon. Write a postcard home describing what you see, who you meet and how you feel.</p> <p>4. Be an Astronomer Make a moon and stars diary. Look at the moon each night for a week, draw its shape and note any changes. Look at the stars with an adult and draw what you see.</p> <p>5. Be an Explorer Find out some interesting facts about a famous astronaut (e.g. Tim Peake, Neil Armstrong, Mae Jemison) Create a mini fact file or poster.</p>	<p>1. Be an Artist Can you create a picture or collage of an animal found in Africa, make an animal mask or design an African pattern for clothing?</p> <p>2. Be a Historian Can you research and find out about a famous landmark in Africa?</p> <p>3. Be a Researcher Can you find out facts and create a fact file for Africa e.g. the flag, climate, animals, traditional food?</p> <p>4. Be a Designer Can you make a Lego model of an animal/landmark or make a junk model animal?</p> <p>5. Be a Musician Can you research what instruments they use in Africa and then make your own version?</p> <p>6. Be a Scientist Choose an African animal and find out about the habitat they live in.</p> <p>7. Be a Chef Can you create a dish traditional to Africa?</p> <p>8. Be a Detective Can you ask family/friends and find out if anyone has been to Africa? Ask them questions or to look at their pictures.</p>
