Below is a list of activities you can undertake over the next half term & link them to your class genre and focus artists above:

- Learn a song written/performed by your focus artist.
- Create a fact file/ PowerPoint presentation about your genre.
- Explore the main instruments used in your genre and see if you can recreate your own version of one of these using different items around your house or garden.
- Listen to a famous piece of music from your genre and answer the following questions about it:

Which instruments can you hear?

What is the mood of the piece?

How does it make you feel?

Explain the dynamics

What is the pitch like?

What is the tempo? Does it change?

Other music-based activities :

- Write your own lyrics to a song
- Have a play around on Incredibox and compose your own piece of music.
- Play on an online virtual keyboard
- Revise the instrument families and create a poster for the music room when we go back to school.
- Revise the different note values and come up with a way to remember them! (Crotchet, Quaver, Minim, Semibreve)
- Download Magic Piano from the app store and practice playing along to different tunes.
